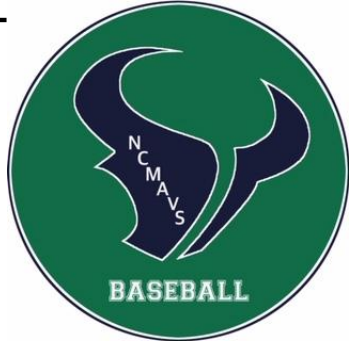

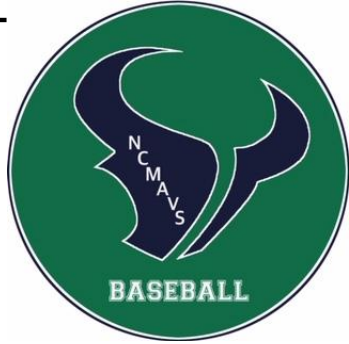


Our Mission

We teach baseball, discipline and respect both on and off the field

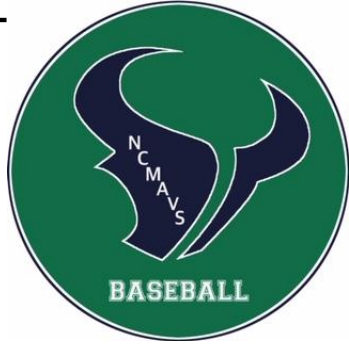
Levels are based on grade, not age

11-Month Program

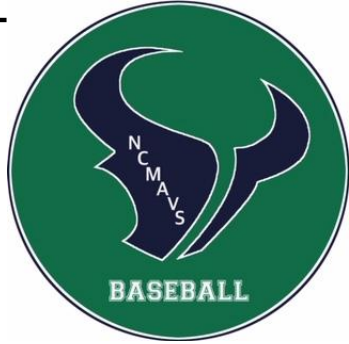

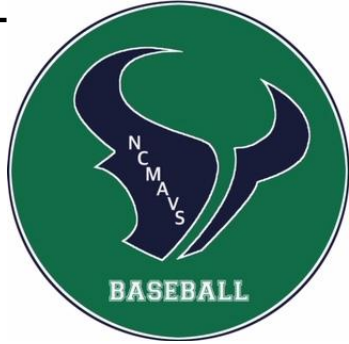

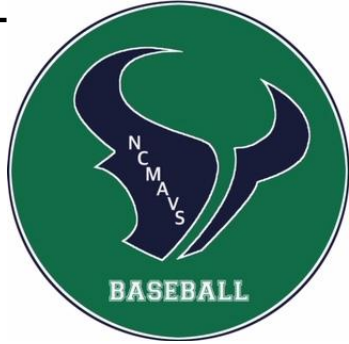
Roster Teams

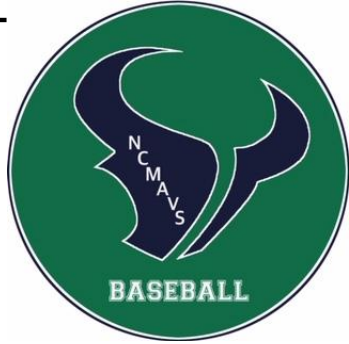

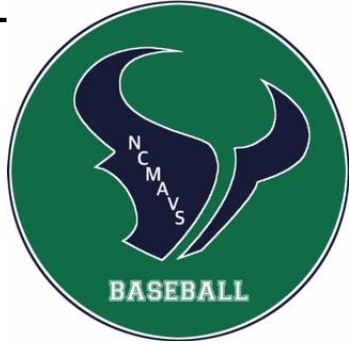

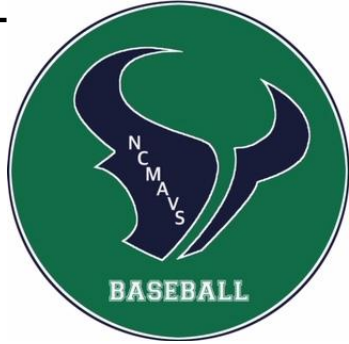
Tournaments

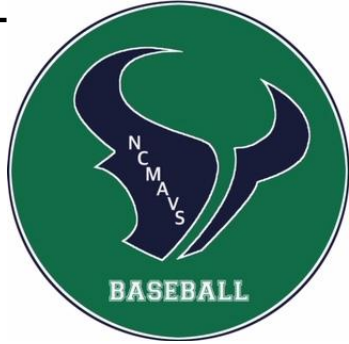

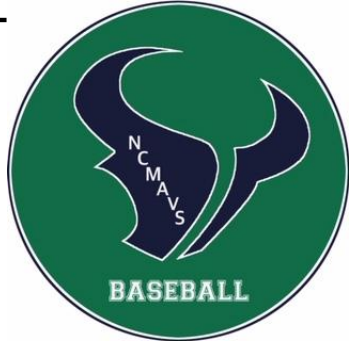

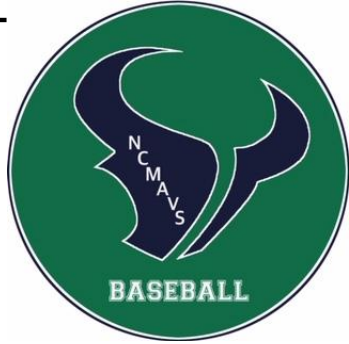
